## There really is no comparison.

Since 1972, Syracuse University Project Advance (SUPA) has offered an innovative departure from traditional high school/university partnerships. Instead of a curriculum based on a single exam for credit, SUPA students get a true university learning experience, from the national leader in concurrent enrollment programming.

## Real value for real credit.

SUPA offers the same experience and curriculum offered to Syracuse University students, but at a substantially lower cost. This means great value for students and parents.

## University-level instruction and opportunity

SUPA offers more than 50 different Syracuse University courses to qualified students every year, allowing students a real glimpse into the breadth of university academic programming. Classroom instructors are held to the same rigorous standards as Syracuse University adjunct professors. SUPA instructors are required to have at least a master's degree or equivalent subject-specific experience; they also are required to attend professional training and ongoing seminars in order to maintain qualification as a SUPA instructor. Syracuse faculty visit SUPA classrooms annually to ensure that Syracuse University standards are being met.
