5/1/20

Drop Due date / Spring only and 2nd Sequence Year-Long

If the signed Drop Form is received up to and including on the actual drop date, the course will be dropped and the financial responsibility will be removed. A refund will be processed if payment has been received and an email notification is generated to notify the parent, student and instructor that the drop request has been officially processed. Once a course is dropped, this cannot be reversed!

Pass/Fail Due Date

We are extending the Pass/Fail grading option to all Project Advance students officially enrolled in courses during the Spring 2020 semester. Taking a course pass/fail is OPTIONAL, and we strongly recommend that students speak with their course instructor and/or school counselor first before making a decision. Withdrawal Due Date

A withdrawal is typically chosen if the student has not done as well as anticipated and does not want a low grade reported on their transcript. No refunds are issued and the parent/guardian remains financially responsible for any outstanding balance on the account. An email notification is generated to notify the parent, student and instructor that the withdrawal request has been officially processed.

If you officially registered for your SU course through Project Advance, and your account is up to date (not on financial hold) you are eligible to request an SU transcript and attempt to have your credits transferred. While Project Advance cannot guarantee that your credits will be accepted by another college or university, 90% of our former students report receiving credit recognition of some kind.
